Nederlands:

Giovanni Gabrieli (1555–1612) was componist, organist en priester uit Venetië (Italië). Hij was een belangrijk componist die het begin van de Barok inleidde. Gabrieli liet een uitzonderlijk groot oeuvre van instrumentale muziek na, waaronder vele Canzona's voor blazers waarvan deze "Canzon Quarta" een meesterwerk is.

English:

Giovanni Gabrieli (1555–1612) was a composer, organ player and priest from Venice (Italy). He was an influential composer who heralded the start of the Baroque Era. Gabrieli composed an exceptional great number of instrumental works, including many canzones for brass players. This "Canzon Quarta" is such a canzone masterpiece.

Deutsch:

Giovanni Gabrieli (1555–1612) war ein Komponist, Organist und Priester aus Venedig (Italien). Er war ein wichtiger Komponist der den Anfang des Barocks einleitete. Gabrieli hat eine außerordentliche Menge von Instrumentalmusik komponiert. Unter denen zahlreichen Canzonas für Bläser ist die „Canzon Quarta“, ein wahrhaftes Meisterwerk.
